Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must include postage or be metered and be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service. No hand deliveries accepted during the first 24 hours after the trial opens.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00 pm CDT, Friday, May 27, 2022, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, and/or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All entries MUST be complete.

Additional Exhibitor Information

- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.
- Pinch collars, electric or dummy collars are prohibited. Training collars are allowed.
- The safety of the dogs and handlers is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.
- If your bitch goes into season after the closing date, a full refund of entry fees (less \$8.00 administrative fee per day) will be given. Please notify the trial secretary that your bitch has come into season.
- Entry fee for a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (less \$8.00 administrative fee, AKC service fees (for all classes entered) and judge's fee per day) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of fire, civil disturbances, an Act of God, public emergency or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- The owner or handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs and their children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create an unnecessary disturbance, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the site. In such a case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Manitowoc County Kennel Club, and the trial secretary and their members, agents, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the trial committee.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the AKC or that have AKC Limited Registration, are Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges PAL/ILP registered or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. These events are accepting entries for Mixed Breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. REGULAR CLASSES - Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper jump height. PREFERRED CLASSES - handlers must run their dog in their eligible proper height.

24 inch Choice

Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches and under at the withers. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24 Choice

Measuring & Height Card Information

When filling out the entry form, there is a section of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary can be notified. **There will be no measuring of dogs per the Suggested Best Practices issued by AKC** If your dog is measured, please bring the measured List. It is no longer required that a dog be measured by the Trial Secretary. You may have your dog measured by a professional measurer, but you must bring the measured List to the trial to present upon request. Although exhibitors are encouraged to have their dog measured, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed. Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used. Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring. A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Obstacles & Course Familiarization

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. Contacts & table are rubberized and weaves are 24 inches on center. Obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs will not be offered at this trial. Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk through will be held prior to each class in conjunction with the judge's briefing.

Site Information

Site is **OUTDOORS on grass**. There are two rings, which alternate; size of each ring is 80' x 120'. The rings will be enclosed with snow fencing, and the rings are in a chain-link fenced area. There is limited shade; please bring your own shade and tenting. The building (heated/air conditioned) will be available for indoor crating. DOGS MAY **NOT** BE LEFT OVERNIGHT. Crates may be left overnight, however, Manitowoc County Kennel Club, nor the trial secretary will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

Food and beverages WILL be available for purchase on Saturday & Sunday

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First through Fourth place in all classes. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs with a qualifying score. New Title rosettes, Master Double Qualifier rosettes, Master Triple Qualifier rosettes, AGCH rosettes, MACH rosettes, PACH rosettes and PAX rosettes will also be awarded to teams achieving one of these titles. AGCH, MACH, PACH & PAX bars will also be awarded to teams achieving one of those titles. All prizes and awards must be claimed the day of the trial – none will be mailed.

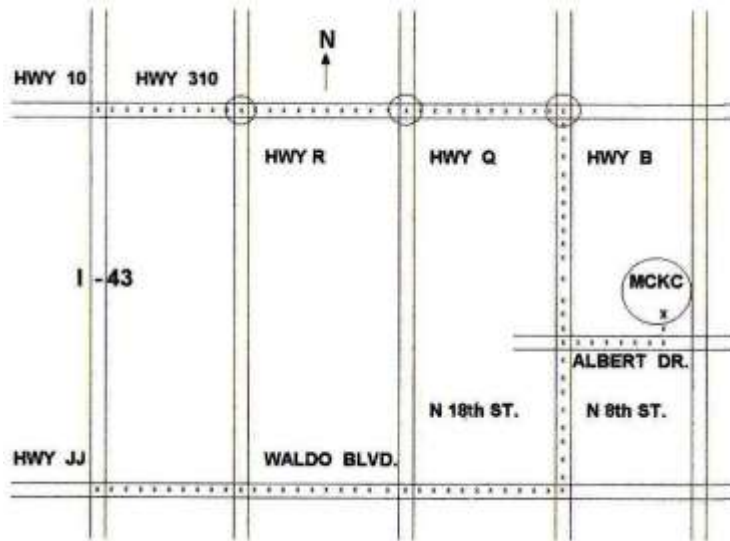

Directions to Manitowoc County Kennel Club

From South: Take I-43 to exit #152 (Waldo Blvd). Turn East and go 3.5 miles to North 8th Street. Turn North (left) and go 1.2 miles to Albert Drive. Turn East (right) and go 0.7 miles to the club grounds on the left.

From West: Take US Hwy 10 to I-43. Road now becomes Hwy 310; continue 3.5 miles to County Hwy B (3rd roundabout). Turn South (right) and go 2 miles to Albert Drive. Turn East (left) and go 0.7 miles to the club grounds on the left.

From North: Take I-43 to Exit #154. Turn East (left) on Hwy 310. Follow "From West" directions above.



Move-Up Regulations & Form

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. However, written notice (regular mail or e-mail) must be given to the Trial Secretary **no later than 6:00 p.m. CDT on Monday, June 6, 2022**. **Day-to-day move ups will be allowed if received before the close of the Friday & Saturday trials** (award of ribbons for the last class of the day will be considered the close of the trial). Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

No verbal changes will be accepted. Written requests must include the information listed below.

Please note that if you do request a move up from a Novice A class to Open, prior to the closing date of this trial, AKC regulations state any other class you may be entered in needs to be moved to the Novice B class. A dog which has been entered in Novice A, but is ineligible due to restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to Novice B under the following conditions: The request must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial **AND** the request must state the reason and justification for the move.

After the close of entries, a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Forms must be received by 6:00 p.m. CDT Monday, June 6, 2022. This change form is only for dogs whose entries have been accepted for the Manitowoc County Kennel Club agility trials on June 10-12, 2022.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
